

**ARMY PUBLIC SCHOOL, YOL CANTT**  
**ANNUAL REPORT**

1. **Brief History of the School.**

(a) Army Public School, Yol Cantt has come a long way since being established in 1976 as '**Dah Nursery School**' catering to the pre-primary educational needs of the children of defence personnel at Yol Cantt. The school has progressed and surpassed all challenges and showed progress in all spheres.

(b) The school was re-designated as **Army School** on 16<sup>th</sup> Feb 1991 and was subsequently affiliated to CBSE in April 1993. The school was upgraded to secondary level in 1995 and further to Senior Secondary level in 1997. With the clarion call '**Truth is God**', the school is on the path of progress with an aim that each and every child should grow up as a responsible citizen in addition to being a rationale and humane individual with a capacity to contribute positively to humanity.

(c) The school was renamed as Army Public School, Yol Cantt wef 01 Jul 2011 vide HQ (AWES) letter No B/45714/WC/AWES dt 11 May 2011.

(d) Army Public School, Yol Cantt is affiliated to CBSE vide CBSE, Delhi letter No CBSE/ AFF/ Govt Wing/ 630040(Old)/ 680004(New)/ 2014/4327 dt 22/27 Jan 2014. This affiliation has been extended by CBSE upto **31 Mar 2025 vide** their letter No CBSE/ AFF/ **630040/ Ex-04572-2021/ 2020-21** dt 17 Oct 2020. At present, the school has strength of 2010 students distributed over class I to XII under 60 sections. For the Senior Secondary level, all three streams viz, Science, Commerce & Humanities are available for the students.

(e) Besides education, adequate weightage is given for all round personality development of students through participation in co-curricular activities & sports. The school has excelled in a number of sporting events in the region. The school has excelled in many events at the Cluster, Comd, State and National level.

(f) A Junior Division of NCC for boys & girls is part of the curriculum where students actively participate in NCC trg/ camps. School has 100 vacancies for JD out of which 33% are reserved are girls cadets.

18. **TAeL.** All classes from I-X are equipped with LCD projectors with suitable audio speakers and classes XI & XII with Flat Smart Panel Screen. Teachers have their own laptops. TAeL is effectively being used by all teachers through laptops. Presentations are being prepared by the concerned teachers and delivered in their respective classes. Interactive boards are installed in Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Computer labs. The school computer labs are also equipped with LCD Projectors.

10. **Communication Skill.** Following steps have been initiated to improve the communication skill of the students:-

(a) All students are motivated in the morning assembly to inculcate the habit of speaking English with correct pronunciation.

(c) English has been implemented as our campus language so that communication among the staff as well as students is also done in English

(d) Language enrichment activities like Extempore, English Debate, Book discussion, etc are conducted as a regular feature.

(e) Participation of students in various competitions organised by CBSE/ AWES like English Debate/ Quiz Competition.

(f) **Subscription of Newspaper.** Subscription of twelve newspapers (Nine in English and three in Hindi) for the school has worked as a catalyst to fulfill the need of the hour. Students after reading the newspaper are able to learn facts and figures, new words in English besides being updated on the current affairs. In addition to this, school has subscribed NIE (Tribune Students' Edition) to the students from class VI to XII.

20. **Upgradation of Laboratories.** All labs have been equipped with adequate instruments and apparatus to facilitate conduct of practical's.

21. **Present Status of School Building.** The new school building was constructed through AMWP in 2015 at present loc to cater for 48 classrooms. Building has full facilities of playgrounds, Activity Shed, Laboratories, Conference Room and Staff Room. The various classes were shifted and commenced functioning from dates as given below:-
