

ARMY PUBLIC SCHOOL, YOL

1. Brief History of the School.

(a) Army Public School, Yol has come a long way since being established in 1976 as '**Dah Nursery School**' catering to the pre-primary educational needs of the children of defence personnel at Yol. The school has progressed and surpassed all challenges and showed progress in all spheres.

(b) The school was re-designated as **Army School** on 16th Feb 1991 and was subsequently affiliated to CBSE in April 1993. The school was upgraded to secondary level in 1995 and further to Senior Secondary level in 1997. With the clarion call '**Truth is God**', the school is on the path of progress with an aim that each and every child should grow up as a responsible citizen in addition to being a rationale and humane individual with a capacity to contribute positively to humanity.

(c) The school was renamed as Army Public School, Yol wef 01 Jul 2011 vide HQ (AWES) letter No B/45714/WC/AWES dt 11 May 2011.

(d) Army Public School, Yol is affiliated to CBSE vide CBSE, Delhi letter No CBSE/ AFF/ Govt Wing/ 630040(Old)/ 680004(New)/ 2014/4327 dt 22/27 Jan 2014. This affiliation has been extended by CBSE upto **31 Mar 2030 vide** their letter No CBSE/**680004**/Ex-01169-2526/2025-26/ dt 15 Apr 2024. At present, the school has strength of 1888 students distributed over class I to XII under 57 sections and now RSAPPS Yol merged with APS Yol having 458 students under 16 sections from Nursery to UKG. For the Senior Secondary level, all three streams viz, Science, Commerce & Humanities are available for the students.

(e) Besides education, adequate weightage is given for all round personality development of students through participation in co-curricular activities & sports. The school has excelled in a number of sporting events in the region. The school has excelled in many events at the **Cluster, Comd, State and National level**.

(f) A Junior Division of NCC for boys & girls is part of the curriculum where students actively participate in NCC trg/ camps. School has 100 vacancies for JD out of which 33% are reserved for girls' cadets.

TAeL DETAILS, COMMUNICATION SKILLS, LABORATORIES

38. **TAeL.** All classes from Nursery to UKG are equipped with LCD projector with display screens and classes I to XII are equipped with Flat Smart Panel Screens. TAeL is effectively being used by all teachers through laptops/Computers. Presentations are being prepared by the concerned teachers and delivered in their respective classes on requirement basis. Interactive boards are installed in Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Computer labs. The school Nursery classes & Computer Labs are also equipped with LCD Projectors.

40. **Communication Skill.** Following steps have been initiated to improve the communication skill of the students:-

(a) All students are motivated in the morning assembly to inculcate the habit of speaking English with correct pronunciation.

(b) All teachers except the Hindi and Sanskrit subjects are advised to teach in English.

(c) English has been implemented as our campus language so that communication among the staff as well as students is also done in English

(d) Language enrichment activities like Extempore, English Debate, Book discussion, etc are conducted as a regular feature.

(e) Participation of students in various competitions organised by CBSE/ AWES like Ethics Bowl, English Debate/ Quiz Competition etc.

(f) **Subscription of Newspapers.** Subscription of twelve newspapers (Nine in English and three in Hindi) for the school has worked as a catalyst to fulfill the need of the hour. Students after reading the newspaper are expected to be able to learn facts and figures, new words in English besides being updated on the current affairs. In addition to this, school has subscribed NIE (Tribune Students' Edition) to the students from class VI to XII.

41. **Upgradation of Laboratories.** All labs have been equipped with adequate instruments and apparatus to facilitate conduct of practical's'.

42. **Present Status of School Building.** The new school building was constructed through AMWP in 2015 at present loc to cater for 48 classrooms. Nursery to UKG classes are running in re-appropriated MES buildings having 17 classrooms. Classes from I to XII are running in new building constr under AMWP. The school has full facilities of playgrounds, Activity Shed, Laboratories, Conference Room and Staff Room. The various classes were shifted and commenced functioning from dates as given below:-

- (a) Primary Wing - Classes III - V wef 21 Jan 2016.
Classes I & II wef 16 Jul 2017.
- (b) Senior Wing - Classes VI - XII wef 14 Jun 2016.

43. **No of Classrooms Existing and Required.** New building initially was capable of accommodating 1750 students in 48 classrooms, however, at present 2346 students are studying in the School. Thus, after division of various large rooms and construction of 08 additional pre-fabricated classrooms out of Grant-In-Aid (GIA)/School Fund, total of 74 (57 +17) classrooms have been catered for.
